East Anglia ONE Onshore cable route construction

Ipswich Road closure – From 0700 on 5 March to 1900 on 11 March 2018

Dear Resident

I am writing to you about construction activity in your area in relation to the East Anglia ONE offshore windfarm project. The onshore cable route associated with the project is approximately 37km (23 miles) in length and is mainly located on farmland with some crossings of public highways, footpaths and bridleways. The route runs from a new substation in Bramford, around the north of Ipswich to Bawdsey, where it connects to the offshore cables.

Where the route crosses the public highway, such as Ipswich Road, the highway will be fully closed to enable the works to be undertaken safely, both to the workforce and the general public. Ipswich Road will be closed from junction with Woodbridge Road to Newbourne Road. Access to Low Farm campsite will be maintained. An approved diversion route will be implemented for the duration of the works as follows:

- East of the closure, the diversion will run via Woodridge Road and Waldringfield Road to Newbourne Road.
- West of the closure, the diversion will run via Newbourne Road to Waldringfield Road and Woodbridge Road.

I apologise for the inconvenience. A full road closure will enable us to complete the work and re-open Ipswich Road as quickly as possible.
