## FRIDAY MORNING YOGA 10:00 - 11:00AM

In these classes, Ian combines elements of Hatha and Vinyasa yoga to create a rounded practice. Ian uses a range of props including blocks, straps, blankets and bolsters to enable everyone to experience each posture in accordance with their body type and age.

Ian's interest is in sharing yoga to everyone - to create a space where you can take some time out for yourself, become aware of your body and breath, providing an opportunity to be in the present moment, without the distraction of thoughts from the past or the future.
